To participate in this project please provide a sketch plan of a garden, or gardens, with a plant list and a description of the garden. The plan should be drawn on a standard A4 or A3 size piece of paper. This will enable the plans to be photocopied more easily so that participants can keep a copy of what they have given for their own record as well.

The description can be as brief as you wish, or it can be a longer description and photographs can be attached if desired. Again, an A4 page format is recommended. The full address of the location of the garden sketched should be attached and whether the garden or evidence of the garden are still there. A photocopied street directory location would be beneficial. The plans and descriptions submitted will not be returned. Information gathered in the **Gardens of Memory Project** will be used to further our knowledge of Australian garden history .
